Welcome to the September Project Management Institute / Great Lakes Chapter (PMI/GLC) PMP Exam Review course. The first day of class is September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019, 7:30 am - 5:00 pm. ## Textbook:

## Pre-Work:

The first three chapters in Joseph Philips's text, CAPM/PMP Project Management Certification (4<sup>th</sup> Edition) are overview chapters, as they are in the PMBOK. Upon receiving your book, please read through the first three chapters. To be ready for Day 1, we ask that do the end of chapter exercises (Chapters 1 - 3). Topics in these chapters include the exam qualification requirements, overview of projects programs and portfolios and basic structure of the PMBOK. We will start Day1 with a short quiz on the reading assignment. Completion of the pre-work fulfills 3 hours of training, and the 4 days of training fulfill the remaining 32 hours of training (for a total of 35 hours).

## The material you will want to bring to class includes:

- PMBOK for reference to PMI project management knowledge areas
- Textbook for reference and work through questions
- Pen, pencil, highlighter, notepad to take notes, mark sections of the text
- Index cards to write notes for flash cards to assist with practice after the class
- PC the textbook includes a CD that will be used in class for completing course practice material and recording quiz outcome
