- 3) Behavioral Component: How attitude influences your behavior

Dweck, Ph.D., a fixed mindset is the belief that your abilities, intelligence, and talents are fixed traits. What do you do when you encounter obstacles? Do you give up easily (fixed) or persist in the face of setbacks (growth)?

Strategies to Develop a Growth Mindset

- 1) Experiment. Try different things to grow.
- 2) View challenges as opportunities.
- Value progress. Learn to appreciate the lessons learned along the way.
- 4) Follow the brain plasticity research. The brain isn't fixed; your mind shouldn't be either!
