

On March 26th, Dr. Harri Emari, PMP, PMIGL Director of Corporate Outreach, joined the PMIxChange event to discuss Project Management in Construction through the Pandemic. The key takeaways from this event were:

- COVID-19 has not left the construction industry untouched. For example, project
  cancellations and lower productivity forced stakeholders to adapt by creating new ways
  of working, such as "remote construction management" and making more use of
  technology, such as 360 cameras for quality control, and even robotic involvement
  where possible.
- Remote working has been mostly observed for those involved with the indoor part of
  the construction process, such as management and planning. Those involved in the
  outdoor activities, such as the actual building of infrastructures, were forced to be in the
  field taking COVID-19 Protection measures: reduced numbers, temperature checks,
  social distancing, etc.).
- When it comes to attracting Gen Z into this industry, we should not be too worried because even though construction is mostly for those who like having their hands dirty on tools and being on the field, which is less and less what Gen Z likes doing, more and more will be done by making effective use of innovative technologies.

Integrated Project Delivery was developed as a solution to construction projects' adversarial relationships, low rates of productivity, high rates of inefficiency and rework, frequent disputes, and lack of innovation, resulting in too many projects that cost too much and take too long to build.

PMPs are proficient in Integration Management for different aspects of a project. The PMBoK Framework is applicable to any type of project, but when it comes to Integrated Project Delivery, there are contractual, psychological, and business management skills needed to successfully carry out the management of a quality end product that mixes Team Culture, Owner Business Objectives, and Contractor's Financial Goals.

Path to an IPD Contract seems to be as simple as agreeing on Business Case, Contract Selection, Team Development, Charettes, and Negotiating Commercial Terms. However, achieving the synergy and collaborative culture within the newly formed triparty agreement and their subs, known as the "IP Team", requires a champion that has interpersonal and business management skills as much as construction project management skills.
